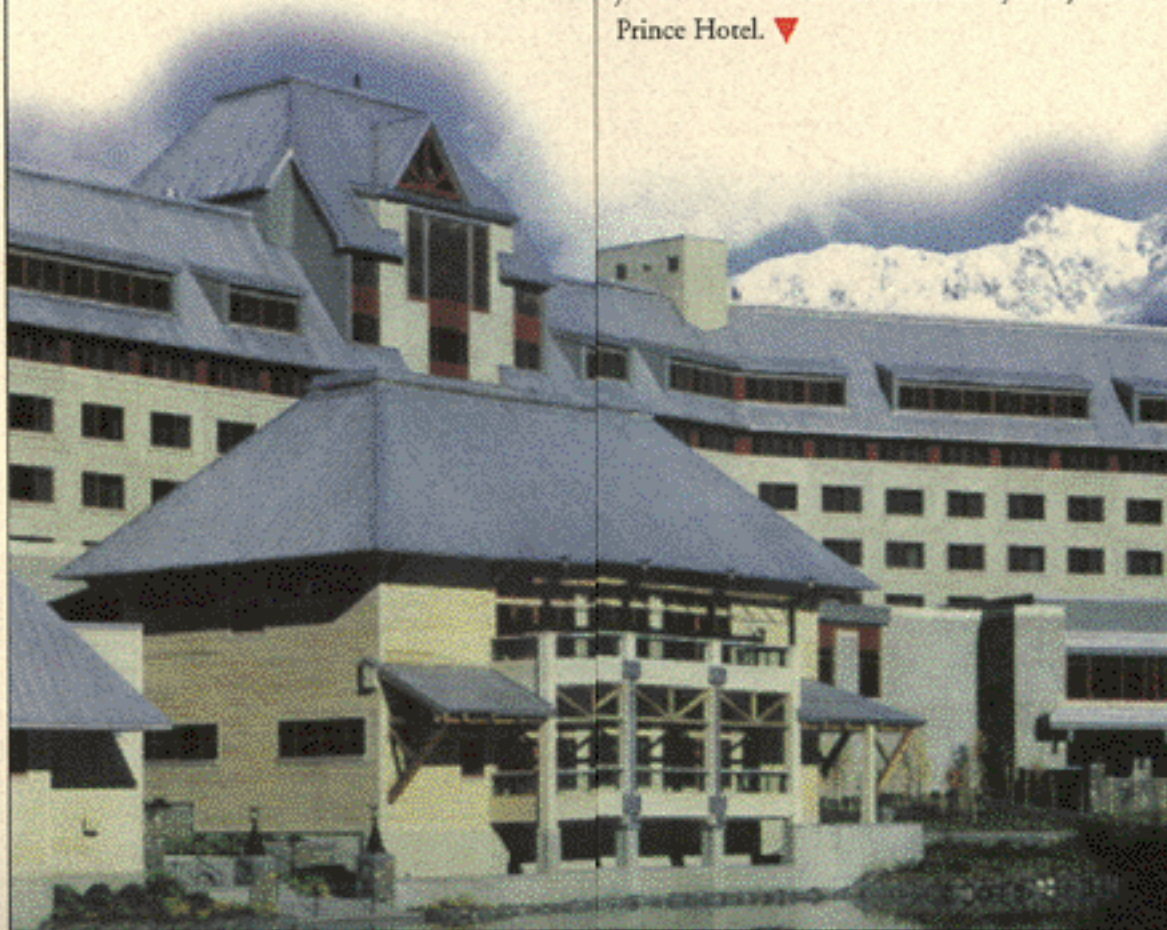

The Alyeska Resort is considered Alaska's first and only year-round destination resort. It encompasses more than 1,500 acres, including Mt. Alyeska, the state's largest ski area; the Anchorage Golf Course; the Alyeska Tramway, a 60-passenger aerial tram; the Glacier Terminal, housing the Glacier Express and Seven Glaciers Restaurants at the 2,300 ft. level of Mt. Alyeska; and the jewel of the resort – the chateau-style Alyeska Prince Hotel. ▼



The Alyeska Tramway rises 2,300 ft. above the valley floor and offers sweeping views of the Girdwood valley and adjacent Turnagain Arm. The 60-passenger car is enclosed with large viewing windows that allow you to see the surrounding mountains and glaciers. Keep your eyes open and you may even see a moose, beaver, marmot, or bear foraging below. The Tram carries you up the dramatic north face of Mount Alyeska to the Glacier Terminal where you'll find an observation deck that looks out on the Alyeska resort and a view noted by *Condé Nast Traveler* magazine as being the best of any North American ski area.
